Text b offers “Gitarrentaschen in verschiedenen Größen zu verkaufen.” Text a offers instrument repairs and strings.

Text b explicitly offers Sunday breakfast and “Auch vegan: Brot, Obst und Gemüseaufstriche, ganz ohne Milch, Eier und Fleisch.” Text a offers a fixed menu containing egg and cheese.
