F seeks unpaid Saturday assistance and gives the matching duties: “Sie begrüßen die Gäste und prüfen ihre Eintrittskarten.”

A combines genre, physical format and larger type: “In der Buchhandlung Seitenblick finden Sie Krimis und spannende Romane als gedruckte Großdruckausgaben.”

Daria's exclusive written arrangement entails support for the full prohibition: "Auch wer irgendwann einen Anruf erlaubt hat, sollte nur noch schriftliche Bitten bekommen."
