“Diese Lücken” refers directly to the incomplete and contradictory archival material, while “erzählerischer Spielraum” prepares the discussion of constructing transitions and motives. Option j has a plausible anaphoric link to the uncertain source record but contradicts the article’s argument that uncertainty should not simply be eliminated.

18: d

The sentence states what retaining conflicting accounts reveals: the interests that shaped the respective reports. Option j contradicts both the preceding rejection of harmonization and the following proposal to represent multiple perspectives.

19: c

“Dieser Erwartung” resumes the audience’s demand for clarity and introduces the inadequacy of a general on-screen notice discussed next.
