The expression sich mit einer Frage auseinandersetzen requires mit and the dative.

3: d

The required collocation is die Aufmerksamkeit auf etwas lenken.

4: b

Reaching agreement on rules requires sich auf etwas verständigen; die refers to plural Gesprächsregeln.

5: c

The model supplies the means of demonstrating the connection process.

6: d

The preceding observation, 'Auch bei einer störungsfreien Leitung können deutlich hörbare Worte missverstanden werden', supplies the reason for the design decision.

7: a

The fixed expression einem Umstand Rechnung tragen means taking a circumstance into account.

8: b

Dessen expresses that the margins belong to the singular neuter Gesprächsbuch.

9: b

The source assigns replacement transport offers to the customer's freight forwarder. Airport handling coordination belongs to airport management, while aircraft and crews remain the airlines' responsibility.

10: c

Limited hall space, particularly areas for goods requiring special storage conditions, explicitly causes the delivery pause. The access road remains usable and receiving staff are available.

11: a

The nearer airport cannot transfer the oversized shipment with its available equipment. The more distant location is selected because it can load the freight onto the aircraft. Extended storage is not the reason, and the acceptance appointment is confirmed before departure.

12: b

The article explicitly identifies the consequences of delay for the recipient as decisive. It excludes goods value and explains why an originally early delivery date need not retain priority.

13: c

Existing freight, arriving aircraft, staff and equipment must be coordinated within limited handling capacity. Simultaneous arrival of all delayed transports would create another bottleneck. Continuing runway repairs and renewed customer approval are not given as reasons.

14: a

Accounting compares original orders with actual transports to prevent reserved but unused services from being billed as performed. Receipt confirmation belongs to customer service, and the retrospective comparison does not authorise road transport reservations.

15: b

The final paragraph explicitly adds the consequences of delay alongside the requested delivery date. It neither assigns an alternative airport to every shipment nor replaces the requested date with a nonbinding period.

17: f

Ungewissheit refers to the unresolved location, time and completeness. 'Die Redaktion müsste sich die ursprüngliche Datei beschaffen' begins the ensuing verification steps.

18: d

Diese Menschen refers to the pedestrians and cyclists just introduced. The following 'was eine solche Fahrt für sie bedeuten könnte' maintains that referent.

19: g

Technische Möglichkeit refers to making faces and registration plates unrecognisable. The following sentence supplies the editorial criterion for showing footage.

20: a

Verzögerung refers to publication 'erst mit zeitlichem Abstand'. The subsequent continuing danger illustrates the condition limiting that delay.

21: h

So summarises the proposed description, street diagram and explanation. 'Das Ereignis würde damit keineswegs verschwiegen' develops the consequence of this alternative reporting.

22: i

The sentence qualifies the previous discussion of high viewing figures. 'Auch ein kaum beachteter Beitrag könnte riskantes Fahren verherrlichen' explains why low reach is insufficient evidence.

23: j

Unterscheidung refers to understanding an event versus the attraction of spectacle. The following sentence applies this distinction to 'jedes verwendete Bild'. Options c and e remain unused: the commentary proposes neither a spatial relocation nor a contact person collecting reports.

Only Dorn compares local purchasing discretion with mandatory external procurement: 'Selbst bei ähnlichen Zimmerumsätzen würden dadurch unterschiedliche Unternehmen an den Ausgaben der Gäste verdienen.'

25: 0

None of the contributions discusses differential admission prices or their effect on residents' access. The claim is absent rather than contradicted.

26: a

Aydin states: 'Eine gut besuchte Versammlung sagt wenig aus, wenn Grundstück, Größe und Nutzung des Gebäudes vorher verbindlich beschlossen wurden.' Neither other contributor makes this claim about consultation timing.

27: c

Sommer describes appreciative intentions followed by pressure to fulfil a cultural role: 'Müssen beide dann das vertraute Bild bedienen, wird aus Anerkennung eine Rolle, aus der sie nur schwer heraustreten können.'

28: a

Only Aydin explicitly includes residents without property: 'Solche Bewohner sollten ihre Anliegen unabhängig davon einbringen können, ob ihnen ein Stück Boden gehört.'

29: c

Sommer requires that hosts may refuse access to domestic routines and explains: 'Gerade ein Nein könnte zeigen, dass die Begegnung von beiden Seiten gestaltet wird.'

30: 0

No author proposes a profit transfer or a locally administered fund. Dorn discusses procurement relationships and employment continuity, which do not entail this proposal.
