The following description of arrows linking premises and conclusions establishes the overview's instrumental function.

Open participation motivates questions that do not depend on complete prior reading.

4: c

The immediately preceding sentence explicitly completes the reconstruction phase.

5: b

The instrumental construction 'durch' with an accusative noun phrase identifies comparison of passages as the method. The following sentence describes what that comparison reveals. This preserves R2.29 without repeating the 'mithilfe' construction in item 2.

6: d

The preceding sentence withdraws the final ranking; the carrier supplies the alternative.

The fixed expression requires 'auf' with an accusative complement.
