### 1: b

The reflexive construction requires the collocation sich ein Urteil bilden.

### 2: d

Participant choice and adaptable templates establish the direction of service. Umgekehrt reverses that relationship.

### 3: a

Deren expresses possession and agrees with the feminine singular antecedent Materialsammlung.

### 4: c

The preceding sentence establishes different needs for overview and detailed argument. Providing both versions follows from those needs.

### 5: b

Einwände erheben is the required lexical collocation.

### 6: c

Sich widmen requires a dative complement. Denen agrees with the plural antecedent Fragen.

### 7: a

The preceding sentence describes close guidance. Dennoch introduces the qualification that participants retain authority over their judgment.

### 8: d

The cards are the means used to demonstrate the procedure, as their movement between stations confirms.

The intended object is the editorial construction of a collective image through selection and arrangement.

The proposed treatment distinguishes the portrayed women's accounts from editorial interpretation.

**12: c**

The stated purpose concerns retrospective interpretation across life stages.

**13: a**

For this subgroup, the proposed approach uses self positioning rather than assigning identity through residence.

**14: b**

The article must explicitly make contextualizing editorial purposes and selection conditions a prerequisite for comparison.

**15: c**

The proposed procedure retains these portraits and records missing biographical information as a feature of their published presentation.

### 16: d

Schlagwort refers to Bürokratie. The following contrast between repeated transcription and uncertainty about documentation specifies the different problems.

### 17: g

Dazu refers to distinguishing necessary documentation from duplicate work. The next sentence follows an order through successive stages and supplies the concrete procedure.

### 18: a

Diese Vorarbeiten retrieves sorting files, removing obsolete templates and aligning terminology. Diese Stunden then refers to the time required for that preparation.

### 19: j

The preceding sentence distinguishes fluent drafting from permission to send. The following questions concern checking commitments, authorization and corrections.

### 20: f

The two preceding business situations establish unequal effects of fixed visits. Deshalb introduces the resulting need for individual calculations.

### 21: h

Eine solche Absage refers to the preceding decision against participation. Avoiding later coordination costs explains its positive evaluation.

### 22: e

Diese Zuständigkeit retrieves the assigned coordination role. Competing routine work and absences explain why that responsibility must persist.

### 23: b

Damit summarizes the defined trial, named coordinator and review date. The subsequent review explains how the agreement can be evaluated. Options c and i remain unused.

## Teil 4

**24: b**

Acar states: „müsste auch eine knappe Darstellung diese Unterschiede sichtbar machen.“ The other contributions address discovery, maintenance and assistance rather than the substantive content of summaries.

**25: 0**

No contribution proposes allocating printed mailings according to previous voting frequency. Voss discusses routes of access without identifying priority recipients.

**26: c**

Brenner recommends assistance „ohne zu sagen, welcher Partei sie zuneigt oder welche politische Forderung sie unterstützt.“ Neither other author discusses disclosure during assistance.

**27: a**

Voss explains that someone unable to use a dense page „würde möglicherweise nie erfahren, dass es die Aufnahme gibt.“ Only her contribution discusses discoverability.

**28: b**

Acar explicitly rejects „von stockendem Lesen auf ein mangelndes Verständnis politischer Zusammenhänge zu schließen“ and describes the ability to weigh interests and consequences.

**29: 0**

No author makes independent completion of written information a prerequisite for assistance. Brenner discusses how assistance should be conducted.

**30: a**

For a correction in the main version, Voss requires that „die Aufnahme und die sprachlich vereinfachte Fassung diese Berichtigung ebenfalls erhalten.“ Only Voss discusses updates after publication.
