1: b

The expression Vertrautheit vermitteln describes the impression created by a regularly heard voice.

2: d

The preceding sentence establishes the voice as a dependable part of the routine: “zu einem verlässlichen Bestandteil des morgendlichen Ablaufs”. Its absence can consequently disrupt that routine.

3: a

The altered recordings are the material used to examine the effect of vocal delivery.

4: c

“Der Wortlaut bleibt in sämtlichen Fassungen identisch.” establishes unchanged wording, against which the changed impression is presented as a concession.

5: b

Detailed recognition of “selbst kleine Eigenheiten” contrasts with limited knowledge of the presenter as a person. Both conditions coexist.

6: d

The fixed expression einer Sache Rechnung tragen means taking something into account.

7: a

The preceding procedure, “zunächst einzelne kurze Abschnitte gemeinsam mit der bisherigen”, provides the opportunity for adjustment.

8: c

The plural antecedent Übergänge requires genitive plural deren to express whose Gestaltung is being described.

The proposed outcome is willingness to begin an unfamiliar kind of book.

10: c

Concrete titles clarify individual interpretations of genre labels.

11: a

The planned contrast concerns an explicit connection between established interests and unfamiliar features.

12: c

The behavioral intention concerns continuing the reading.

13: b

The exception preserves the requirement that the book itself be unfamiliar.

14: a

The reason separates a situational constraint from a response to the book.

15: c

An initial reading decision does not establish completion.

16: f

The distinct proposed uses precede the gap. The following phrase “welches Vorhaben zuerst verwirklicht werden sollte” develops the missing ranking of goals.

17: b

Agreement on priorities precedes the gap. The invitation then raises the separate issue of representation through “Welche Personen könnten zusagen und dort Zusicherungen machen”. The pronoun ihrem refers to the initiative.

18: e

“Jeder dürfte kommen” establishes formal openness. The following night shift and childcare examples show how meetings without a fixed ending could exclude people in practice.

19: i

The antecedent is the members who “nur unregelmäßig dabei sein könnten”. The following submission period provides the participation route introduced by the missing sentence.

20: c

“nach diesem einen Termin enden” supplies the restriction summarized by Eine solche Begrenzung. Renewed authorization for a further negotiation follows.

21: a

Diese Aufgaben refers to maintaining contacts, booking rooms and distributing minutes. The following sentence explains how “solche wiederkehrenden Pflichten” could be shared.

22: j

The procedure records “die Gründe der Minderheit” beside a majority decision. The following sentence explains later access to “der damalige Einwand”.

23: g

The feminine singular referent is Organisationsstruktur. The following “Nach einem gemeinsam bestimmten Zeitraum” supplies the review timing, followed by participation and work completion as criteria. Options d and h remain unused.

Teil 4

24: b

Weber applies the questions used for a permanent public square to seasonal access planning: “auch für einen saisonalen Ort eine öffentliche Planungsaufgabe”. Berger discusses ecological effects of specific passages, not this public space principle.

25: 0

No contribution addresses mandatory reservations or their effect on conflicts. Access planning and marking existing passages do not establish this claim.

26: a

Neumann contrasts “das Gefühl haben, längst angekommen zu sein” with limited knowledge of routes and access. Only her contribution addresses familiarity produced by shared images.

27: c

For the hypothetical sensitive shoreline, Berger states that “dieser wiederholte Weg stärker ins Gewicht fallen” could matter more than the total number of people in the wider area. The statement preserves this possibility rather than asserting an unconditional rule.

28: b

Weber recommends accommodating spectators through “eine Sitzmöglichkeit mit freiem Blick auf das Geschehen”. Neumann's inclusion argument concerns photographic representation, not spatial design.

29: a

Neumann explains that a sports-only gallery would omit other visitors: “Der Ausflugsort erschiene dann als Umgebung einer einzigen Nutzergruppe.”

30: 0

No author compares organized events with individual excursions. Berger's ecological argument concerns the location and concentration of passage, not a preferred organizational form.
