Prior familiarity affects the treatment of the specific film assessment, not participation as a whole.

Diese Grenze refers to qualified confidentiality; Erst mit diesem Wissen then depends on the proposed prior explanation.

20: j

Zwischenzeiten refers to the weeks before training begins; Bis dahin introduces support during that interval.

21: a

Ein solcher Rückzug identifies the missed appointments caused by embarrassment; the next sentence provides a route back.

22: i

Beides refers to the two preceding purposes; the following sentences distinguish the institutions responsible for them.

23: d

The preceding conclusion requires continued availability across disruptions; the next sentence applies that requirement as an evaluation criterion. Option b introduces a database prerequisite unsupported by the surrounding argument. Option f requires an explicitly expressed request to pause counselling contact, which no gap supplies. At gap 21, missed appointments and possible embarrassment do not establish such a request; at gap 17, the wish concerns refusing errands rather than pausing counselling.

24: 0

No contribution recommends temporary joint management when several siblings seek leadership. Individual conversations, operational planning and community narratives do not establish this claim.

25: 0

No author proposes recurring income for siblings. Berger discusses paying for necessary replacement labour, which does not establish a sibling income entitlement.

26: a

Wendt distinguishes practical help from an unmade succession decision: “Daraus einen bereits gefassten Entschluss zur Nachfolge abzuleiten, würde ihre Mitarbeit mit einer Entscheidung verwechseln, die noch gar nicht gefallen ist.”

27: b

Berger conditionally links ending an unsustainable service to continuing the farm: “Unter solchen Bedingungen wäre gerade die Aufgabe eines vertrauten Angebots ein Beitrag dazu, den Hof fortzuführen.”

28: c

Lind describes neighbours repeatedly presenting one brother as successor: “Solche Erzählungen verleihen einer Person einen scheinbar selbstverständlichen Vorrang, obwohl in der Familie vielleicht noch keine Entscheidung getroffen wurde.”

29: a

Wendt explicitly preserves family membership after another career choice: “Wer einen anderen Beruf wählt, sollte weiterhin selbstverständlich zu Familienfesten eingeladen werden und als Tochter oder Sohn denselben Platz in der Familie behalten.”

30: b

Berger includes relatives' unpaid repairs and order processing in future planning: “Diese Leistungen erscheinen auf keiner Lohnabrechnung, werden aber weiterhin gebraucht.” He then examines availability and replacement resources.
