The planned scene supports an inference about attention being directed by expected prices, without stating that conclusion.

2: a

The key paraphrases an explicit benefit concerning relationships among works in one sequence.

3: d

The figurative wording implies a reservation about prescribed appreciation rather than inadequate information.

4: b

The item preserves the limited chronological scope of a stated documentation gap.

5: c

The key retains the explicit condition of institutional curatorial independence.

6: a

The item identifies the stated reason for one museum's decision, not a general limitation of museums.

7: b

The planned contrast supports an inference about independent aesthetic attention.

8: d

The item requires an inference across two time frames rather than retrieval of opening conditions.

9: b

The key paraphrases a specific proposal for continued documentary access.

10: c

The item retrieves the stated editorial priority in the conclusion, distinct from the archival proposal.

11: c

The section combines easier camera and gripper replacement with continuing dependence through configuration formats and maintenance arrangements. This qualification is captured only by c.

12: e

Consistent demonstration conditions are contrasted with variable positioning, damp surfaces and restarts. The central point is the limited evidence a prepared demonstration provides about routine operation.

13: a

Grip locations, pressure marks and discoloration illustrate practical judgments needed to configure equipment. Ordinary language input does not supply these judgments.

14: g

The common directory contains functions and agreed meanings, while individual production records remain with each business. This distinction supports g.

15: f

The section distinguishes proposing, checking and authorizing changes. Accessible input does not determine decision authority.

16: d

Economic viability explicitly depends partly on allowing learning and adjustment time alongside production obligations. Neither unused statement is supported: compulsory sharing of production records is absent, and purchase price is not the primary selection criterion.

17: e

“Aus der Einladung” refers back to Derya's invitation. The agreement to rehearse together supplies the antecedent for “Für dieses gemeinsame Üben” after the gap.

18: b

“Der missglückte Übergang” resumes the failed attempt immediately before the gap. The distinction between musical judgment and synchronization skills explains the subsequent allocation of selection and transition work.

19: g

The paragraph explains the unexpectedly quiet entrance through speaker placement. “Diese Anordnung” then refers to the positions and orientation introduced in g.

20: a

Equal prominence resolves the preceding disagreement over publicity. “Trotz dieses Kompromisses” requires this agreement before contrasting it with guests' attention to Mara.

21: f

Mara responds to the seated audience by selecting a familiar track, while Jonas manages its introduction. “Mit dieser Änderung” resumes that selection change and introduces the audience response.

22: c

Packing follows the final applause and precedes Mara's return to the empty rehearsal room. Her request to practise again is developed by her written notes. Paragraph d requires an absence and delivered recording that the reportage never establishes.

23: c

Only c requires transfer to another team member when the employee is personally involved: “geben Sie deren Bearbeitung an ein anderes Mitglied des Teams ab”.

24: a

Only a combines evening committee attendance with “entsprechende Freistellung am Tag”. The other advertisements specify daytime visits, office hours or flexible project scheduling.

25: d

Advertisement d requires delivery to the regional association, which is “organisatorisch von der untersuchten Gemeindeverwaltung getrennt” and publishes the findings itself.

26: b

Advertisement b states an explicit alternative: “entweder einen Studienabschluss in Sozialer Arbeit oder mehrjährige einschlägige Praxis in der aufsuchenden Beratung”.

27: a

Only a requires recording “die abweichenden Auffassungen”, including those that “keine Mehrheit gefunden haben”.

28: d

Advertisement d explicitly states that employment “endet mit dessen Abschluss”. Advertisement b instead gives an eighteen month duration; a and c offer indefinite employment.

29: c

Advertisement c assigns case evaluation and proposals while stating: “Die verbindliche Entscheidung im jeweiligen Fall verbleibt bei der zuständigen Verwaltungsstelle.”

30: b

Only b prescribes an initial accompanied visiting phase and states: “Erst nach dieser Phase übernehmen sie eigene Besuche selbstständig.”
