The planned alterations service is on the fourth floor.

**13: x**

The only shop selling children's glasses is closed on Saturday. The online talk offers information rather than glasses for purchase. No advertisement meets both conditions.

**14: h**

Advertisement h offers books for the child's age, explicitly specifies large print and permits borrowing them for home use.

**15: d**

Advertisement d explicitly combines the requested topic, live participation from home and questions after the talk.
