Übungssatz 1

Leseverstehen: 75 Punkte, 25 % der Gesamtprüfung. Sprachbausteine: 30 Punkte, 10 %. Das hier zusammengefasste Modul umfasst 105 von 300 Punkten. Die geschlossenen Aufgaben werden anhand des Lösungsschlüssels ausgewertet; es gibt keine zusätzlichen ganzheitlichen Sprachkriterien. Ein isoliertes Modul ist kein Bestehen der gesamten telc Prüfung. Erforderlich sind mindestens 135 von 225 Punkten in der Schriftlichen und 45 von 75 Punkten in der Mündlichen Prüfung; PDF-Seiten 47–48.

The stated purpose is comparison with customers' own garments. All alternatives concern plausible uses of garment measurements, so the intended use must be established by the article.

10: b

The item distinguishes the documented operational change from other plausible responses to workload.

14: x

The sole wheelchair rental permits collection and return only on weekdays and offers no delivery. No other advertisement meets the need.

15: a

The room combines step free access, a low group rate and recurring evening reservations.

16: h

The offer provides free individual budget planning. The person's stated continuing employment meets the eligibility condition for evening appointments.

17: e

The moderated video group matches the participant role, topic and remote access requirement.

36: o

Unschwer expresses that the distinction is readily recognizable from clear headings and times.

37: a

Teilnehmen governs an with dative.

38: h

Für introduces the intended audience in bestimmt sein.

39: l

Statt introduces the activity replaced by collecting consultation questions.

40: d

Einen technischen Fehler beheben is the collocation for resolving the reported fault.
