Leseverstehen: 75 Punkte, 25 % der Gesamtprüfung. Sprachbausteine: 30 Punkte, 10 %. Das hier zusammengefasste Modul umfasst 105 von 300 Punkten. Die geschlossenen Aufgaben werden anhand des Lösungsschlüssels ausgewertet; es gibt keine zusätzlichen ganzheitlichen Sprachkriterien. Ein isoliertes Modul ist kein Bestehen der gesamten telc Prüfung. Erforderlich sind mindestens 135 von 225 Punkten in der Schriftlichen und 45 von 75 Punkten in der Mündlichen Prüfung; PDF-Seiten 47–48.

The central change is the team's delivery of its advice service in residential courtyards, making it accessible during residents' everyday activities.

2: h

The shared renovation protects the existing meeting space and enables evening gatherings to continue at their usual time.

3: g

The changes to the handouts and presentation address visitors' difficulty understanding specialist vocabulary.

4: j

Tasks of different durations replace fixed duty periods, allowing members to contribute according to their availability.

5: f

Residents participate in repairing their existing screens. Installation remains their own responsibility after the meeting.

The answer preserves the editorial condition and the limited extent of translation.

8: a

The explicitly stated purpose is independent initial listening.

9: b

Both registration and a personal connection are required; musical expertise is not the criterion.

10: c

The stated revision concerns the length of spoken contributions and its intended result.

11: h

Advertisement h combines an adult beginner audience, practical filming and use of participants' own smartphones.

12: c

Advertisement c teaches computer editing with existing footage, including selecting and connecting scenes.

13: k

Only advertisement k explicitly offers audio description. Subtitles and step free access in e do not meet the stated sensory access need.

14: x

No advertisement offers paid technical work. The only recruitment offer concerns unpaid audience reception, while i offers a lecture.

15: a

Advertisement a offers separately arranged screenings for adult education groups outside the regular schedule.

16: f

The volunteer audience reception role can be undertaken exclusively in the evening.

17: j

The filmmaker attends the screening in person and answers audience questions afterward.

18: d

Advertisement d supplies online access to complete films for private home viewing during a specified period.

19: l

Advertisement l lends both requested pieces of equipment to associations for individual evenings.

20: g

Advertisement g provides a film with express permission for the association's agreed public screening.

21: b

Trotzdem expresses the concession between the stated intention to wait for clarity and the application already submitted while uncertainty continues. Deshalb would make the intention to wait a reason for applying already. Andernfalls would introduce a conditional alternative that the reported completed action does not express.

22: a

The masculine singular antecedent Antrag requires the accusative object pronoun ihn.

23: c

Deren expresses possession in the relative clause and refers to the female colleague.

24: a

Die Initiative ergreifen is the established expression for taking initiative.

25: b

After mit dem, the adjective modifying the masculine dative noun Kurs takes the weak ending en.

26: a

Teilnehmen governs an with the dative.

27: c

Eine Entscheidung treffen is the required verb and noun combination.

28: b

Vereinbar mit expresses compatibility between course times and existing work shifts.

29: c

Könnten expresses an optional, tentative proposal whose timing depends on Robin's willingness and availability. Müssen introduces an obligation and dürfen introduces permission, neither of which is established here. The finite modal precedes wir after the initial conditional clause.

30: a

Würde with anfangen supplies the conditional consequence of the hypothetical bekäme clause.

Mit etwas rechnen means to expect something, here additional customer questions.

34: c

Aufgrund introduces the spatial limitation as the cause of the rotating display.

35: g

Erhöhen is transitive and takes die Zahl der Sitzplätze as its object. Steigen cannot take that direct object.

36: o

Unschwer expresses ease of recognition, supported by the visible placement of the closures.

37: b

The fixed expression is Wert auf etwas legen.

38: a

Sich an etwas orientieren governs an with the dative when expressing guidance by needs.

39: l

Statt introduces buying a new pair as the alternative avoided by replacing the strap.

40: d

Einen Defekt beheben means to remedy a defect, here the damaged replaceable strap.
