The local assistant is restricted to an internal trial and is not used for routine correspondence.

17: x

Participation and activities are described, but recruitment and voluntariness are not stated.

18: +

Paragraph 6 identifies templates, permissions and document routing as additional requirements.

19: x

Readiness measures do not establish a management decision or a scheduled business year. Neither is reported.

20: +

Her appreciation of drafting assistance is qualified by concern about routines limiting future alternatives.

21: –

The planned sequence explicitly requires review and approval before external dispatch.

22: +

Paragraph 10 explicitly holds the anonymized task material constant.

23: –

Provider origin is explicitly one consideration within a broader assessment of practical control and portability.

The article integrates present convenience with preserved future choice. Local operation and review procedures are supporting aspects.

The outages are the cause of postponement.

30: a

The fixed expression denotes accepting an unwelcome consequence.

31: d

A possessive relative pronoun refers to the plural antecedent.

32: b

The unreal past consequence requires the subjunctive auxiliary with the past participle.

33: c

The verb governs 'an' with the dative.

34: d

The expression describes features becoming more apparent.

35: a

The proportional comparative construction pairs 'je' with 'desto'.

36: b

The menu received criticism; an inflected attributive past participle is required.

37: c

The clause identifies the source of the indirectly reported improvement.

38: d

The degree adverb is written as one lowercase word inside the sentence.

39: a

The fixed expression means meeting expectations.

40: b

The feminine antecedent requires a dative relative pronoun governed by the reflexive verb.

41: c

The singular relative subject requires a finite singular form in the reflexive 'lassen' construction.

42: d

The announcement follows as a response to the request for extended access.

43: b

The fixed expression denotes demonstrating viability.

Reportative modality attributes a claim about completed activity to the studio.

In this infinitive clause, 'zu' precedes the modal infinitive while the lexical infinitive remains intact.
