The concluding qualification distinguishes one technical success from recurring service reliability. The final sentences explain the customer's longer planning horizon.

The first paragraph explicitly establishes overlapping clinical employment and paid theater work.

14: x

The text describes employment chronology and professional contacts but gives no family reactions. The quoted professional context establishes neither approval nor disapproval.

15: –

The stated trigger was conflicting schedules. The available theater contract covered one production rather than a permanent position.

16: +

The source explicitly contrasts allowing patients time to respond with creating theatrical tension.

17: x

The article describes uncertain commitments and planning. It provides no earnings amounts or comparison between the two occupations.

18: –

The teacher role occurred in her second theater year. The hospital series offer followed in the next year, reversing the statement's order.

19: x

Continued contact with former colleagues does not establish an employment offer. No return offer is reported or ruled out.

20: +

The author welcomes recognition but evaluates admiration that erases preparation and uncertainty negatively.

21: +

Seidel explicitly requested the inclusion of applications she withdrew, and the organizer incorporated them.

22: –

The advisory assignment was separately agreed for one production. The article explicitly excludes such an assignment from her other engagements.

23: –

Acting remains her intended main occupation. Career discussions are occasional and subordinate to rehearsals and filming.

24: b

The profile integrates career change, new learning and continuity of earlier experience. It neither claims that medical knowledge guarantees an acting career nor describes a transition into medical consultancy.

Unrestricted exterior filming creates an expectation of insight. Remaining unanswered questions violate that expectation, and the next sentence explicitly identifies a contrast.

26: d

The explanation describes persuasive visual clarity that initially makes the service appear ready.

27: d

The following sentence rejects the inference from a successful image to readiness in varied conditions. The negative adverb expresses that rejection.

28: a

The word modifies the adjective serienreifen and therefore remains uninflected.

29: b

Repeated failures cause the interruption. The genitive prepositional phrase expresses that causal relation.

30: d

The fixed expression etwas in Frage stellen means to cast doubt on something.

31: d

The completed installation and subsequent operational failure require a past participle describing the installed component.

32: c

The unreal past condition requires wäre with geblieben in the consequence clause.

33: d

Zu etwas Stellung nehmen is the fixed expression for responding to an issue or objection.

34: d

The shift from denying a delay to acknowledging it licenses eingeräumt. The following clause confirms that acknowledgment.

35: b

Retaining the date runs counter to the expectation raised by acknowledging a delay, creating a concessive relation.

36: b

Mit governs dative, and the definite plural article den requires the weak adjective ending en.

37: d

Wie introduces the attribution of the reported restriction to the director's explanation.

38: c

The degree adverb is written as one word with s and a lowercase initial inside the sentence.

39: d

Zur Geltung kommen describes an effect becoming perceptible through the contrast between promotional language and workshop images.

40: d

The plural relative pronoun requires a plural finite verb. The past perfect passive places sending before the past filming period.

41: b

Der Film is the subject of nennt. The fronted noun phrase is its accusative object.

42: a

The original date has only just been supplied. Its prior absence makes this a threshold after which the discrepancy can be assessed.

43: b

Verzichten governs auf with an accusative complement.

44: b

Will with a perfect infinitive marks the subject's own claim about a past action. The following sentence explicitly identifies that evidential status.

45: d

The complement of Schwierigkeit requires a zu infinitive. With the separable verb zuordnen, the resulting form is zuzuordnen.
