Design differences are described, but printing costs and comparative prices are not reported.

15: –

The warning preceded verification and arose from the unfamiliar appearance, not confirmed misuse.

16: –

The inspected destination contained collection details and explicitly did not request payment.

17: x

The forwarding sequence is described, but the original sender's financial history is absent.

18: +

The complete form supplied an identifying detail missing from the cropped photograph.

19: x

Publication and distribution of the correction are stated. No change in call volume is reported.

20: +

Winter accepts the reasons for caution while rejecting the unsupported certainty of the public allegation.

21: –

The confirmation concerned the submitted form; the text explicitly excludes a review of all circulating notices.

22: +

The original notice remained displayed with an explicitly linked correction directly below it.

23: –

The procedure specifies previously known or independently obtained contact details, contradicting exclusive reliance on the disputed form.

The whole article follows the emergence, verification and correction of an unsupported warning. Form design and internal procedures support that central account.

Angesichts introduces the repeated errors as grounds for reconsidering the settings.

Vorrang vor etwas haben is the fixed expression assigning priority.

31: d

The possessive relative pronoun dessen refers to the neuter singular antecedent System.

32: c

Hätte with bemerkt forms the unreal past result corresponding to the preceding counterfactual condition.

33: a

Übersehen means failing to notice the inquiry, matching the described event.

34: d

In Kauf nehmen means accepting an unwanted consequence.

35: b

Solange specifies the continuing period during which daily review remains necessary. Sobald would mark an onset rather than the duration of the existing problem. Nachdem would present a preceding circumstance rather than the continuing period requiring checks. Obwohl would present unreliability as a circumstance despite which checks occur, whereas the context makes it the reason to maintain them.

36: b

The participial adjective takes the weak ending en after the definite article in the dative plural.

37: d

Wie introduces the clause attributing the reported evaluation to Eva Brandt.

38: c

Übermäßig is the correctly spelled degree modifier in this context.

39: d

Zur Geltung kommen expresses receiving appropriate weight in the selection. Zum Erliegen kommen describes an activity stopping, in Verzug kommen describes falling behind an obligation, and zum Einsatz kommen describes something being deployed. These meanings do not fit the intended recognition of less frequent concerns.

40: d

The plural subject Bedürfnisse requires the finite plural passive berücksichtigt werden.

41: b

Erklären assigns the recipients dative case. Den neuen Beschäftigten is the correctly inflected dative plural phrase. The genitive phrase Des neuen Beschäftigten cannot serve as the recipient. Eva Brandt is the subject.

42: a

Erst dann places adoption after the trial and discussion.

43: b

Bestehen auf with the dative expresses insistence.

44: b

Will with the perfect infinitive attributes an unverified claim about a past action to the subject himself.

45: d

Ermöglicht es requires a zu infinitive; zu is inserted within the separable verb.

46: a

Im Ermessen einer Person liegen assigns discretion to that person.
