Paragraph b retrieves the two dimensions introduced at the end of z and explains their interdependence.

2: e

The opening reference in e requires the loss of knowledge during transfer established in b.

3: c

Paragraph c qualifies the achievement of the continuous record introduced in e by separating traceability from interpretation.

4: a

Paragraph a answers the specific question about responsibility for interpretive information at the end of c.

5: d

Paragraph d retrieves the continuing obligation established in a and concludes the account. The accepted adjacent connections are zb, be, ec, ca and ad.

6: b

The item distinguishes the stated planning decision from plausible but different institutional changes. The key requires explicit information about shared access conditions.

7: a

The item identifies the explicitly stated operational reason for the booking arrangement.

8: c

The item preserves the condition attached to additional supervision and the scope of the exemption.

9: a

The item compares two explicitly allocated responsibilities without treating technical assistance as scientific project ownership.

10: c

The item retrieves the required order of proposal, agreement and implementation, including the accepted scheduling consequence.

11: c

The item distinguishes chronology and cost allocation across the two explicitly described funding phases.

12: b

The item distinguishes a limited review period from indefinite withholding and immediate release.

13: c

The item identifies the explicitly stated scheduling purpose of the planning exercise. All alternatives describe plausible prospective planning purposes under the same assumed usage conditions.

14: b

The item retrieves the stated relationship between existing experience and additional training.

15: c

The item preserves both the observation period and the recurring capacity condition attached to expansion.

Section d explicitly includes preparation, cleaning, revision and maintenance in an exhibition and identifies their usual omission.

17: a

Section a assigns human actions and preferences to impatience, hope and caution.

18: l

The apparent praise for productivity is undermined by the continued unavailability of what is announced.

19: j

Section j explicitly separates repeated circulation of publicity material from discussion of its substantive meaning.

20: c

The author rejects a dismissive response to residents' hopes while expressing hesitation about expansive promises.

21: h

Section h reports an initial vocabulary substitution that leaves participants uncertain about the purpose of their contribution.

22: l

The explicit shift to genuine recognition distinguishes sincere approval of correction from the preceding irony.

23: e

Section e accepts industrial usefulness as one consideration while rejecting it as an exhaustive criterion.

24: x

No section reports a vote on a research building location. Public discussion is described, but the specific event is unstated rather than contradicted.

25: g

The contrasting treatment of technical questions and residents' practical concerns supports the inference about whose interests the discussion admits as relevant.
