1: F

F supplies an independent appraisal method covering responsibility, commercial interests and supporting evidence. Its reusable form permits comparison of websites selected by the student.

2: D

D combines an individual home visit with practical changes to existing furniture. H supplies additional equipment but does not offer the requested consultation.

3: I

No available description supplies both a medical examination and individual treatment advice. Health related subject matter does not establish clinical provision.

4: B

B covers the timing before booking, a joint inspection and the complete route to event rooms and toilets for guests with limited mobility.

5: G

G invites personal placement experiences from several health disciplines and provides moderation focused on communication problems.

6: I

No description offers money for a permanent furniture purchase. Temporary equipment access and advice on existing furniture do not satisfy the financial requirement.

7: H

H offers the required adjustable tabletop unit for a four week home trial with collection and return. D offers advice but no such loan.

8: C

C combines quantity and cost planning with supervised practical cooking for a shared meal.

9: I

The only cooking workshop requires physical attendance. None of the other services offers live cooking instruction from a participant's own kitchen.

10: E

E has recurring lunchtime meetings but permits occasional attendance without registration. Fixed meeting times do not create a commitment to attend regularly.

Planned key: identify the concrete routine used to obtain information for daily decisions.

13: A

Planned key: preserve which element of the restaurant arrangement remains flexible.

14: B

Planned key: identify the purpose of maintaining reserve growing space.

15: C

Planned key: recover who allocates produce and when the allocation occurs.

16: A

Planned key: recover the stated financial consequence of payment timing without converting it into a promise about harvest quantities.

17: B

Planned key: recover both the timing and provisional status of the information.

18: C

Planned key: identify implementation timing as the reason for the absence of an immediate effect.

19: A

Planned key: recover the indirect link from customer experience to later planting decisions.

20: B

Planned key: integrate production planning, payment arrangements and flexible distribution across the article. The conclusion must follow from the complete source.

Lesetext 3: Aussagen prüfen · Wer gestaltet den Blick auf ein Viertel?

21: Ja

Membership expressly includes tenants, and members decide on route design. Ownership is not a condition of participation, so people without residential property can participate.

22: Nein

The article explicitly assigns equal individual voting weight to business owners and other members. Providing meeting space also creates no extra voting rights.

23: Text sagt dazu nichts

The administration is mentioned only in connection with public space use. Later information about operating revenue does not establish how the project was initially financed. The complete article neither confirms nor denies a municipal startup grant.

24: Ja

The internal procedure distinguishes consent to recording from subsequent approval of the selected excerpt for public playback. Initial consent alone is insufficient.

25: Nein

Residents accepted the historical account. Their objections concerned groups interrupting everyday use of the courtyard, which contradicts the claimed primary cause.

26: Ja

The stop moves to a public square while the courtyard's history remains in the presentation. Groups no longer enter the courtyard, preserving everyday use against disruption from these tours.

27: Text sagt dazu nichts

School classes are eligible booking groups. The article gives no booking totals or comparison across periods, so eligibility does not establish an increase after the route revision. No other passage supplies or contradicts that trend.

28: Nein

The member assembly decides how the surplus is used. It includes members without guiding duties, directly contradicting exclusive control by the guiding team.

29: Text sagt dazu nichts

The article establishes that guiding work is paid but specifies neither hourly rates nor other providers' payments. It therefore supports no comparative payment claim in either direction.

30: Ja

The stated concept requires influence over selection and use. Supplying personal memories alone does not meet that condition. The claim is limited to the participation concept developed in the article.
