1: F

F combines grocery assistance with acceptance of individual appointments and no weekly commitment.

2: C

C supplies recorded personal accounts across life stages, with locating information and permission for quotation in presentations.

3: I

The only grocery assistance offer is unpaid. Reimbursement of travel costs does not meet the requirement for earnings.

4: G

G reviews the group's own questionnaire before data collection, addressing comprehension and potentially leading wording.

5: E

E includes direct prototype use by the intended users, observation of opening and holding, and a revision phase.

6: H

H offers weekly meals with guests of different ages from the neighbourhood. Kitchen help is a separate optional arrangement.

7: I

No available description supplies hot prepared meals at home every weekday. Grocery assistance and a weekly meal at a venue each fail decisive requirements.

8: B

B provides individual written contributions that count towards menu selection without requiring public speech.

9: D

D combines observation of portion requests, several weekdays of attendance and written confirmation.

The confirmed observation placement operates only on weekdays. No other description offers the required weekend placement.

The planned agreement changes advance notice and commitment of shifts. Verify its exact scope.

15: A

The planned procedure distinguishes occasional committed help from recurring provision.

16: C

The planned comparison concerns unequal income effects of the same proportional reduction.

17: A

The planned chronology ties the next discussion to experience with an implemented work arrangement.

18: B

The planned qualified benefit applies specifically to a mismatch between closing time and work completion.

19: C

The planned interpretation is a possibility concerning increased clarity, not a diagnosis of the couple's wishes or finances.

20: B

The planned article connects work schedules, care, income and personal decisions without reducing them to one controlling factor.

21: Ja

The assessment explicitly permits a favourable decision judgement alongside failed execution. The claim preserves this possibility rather than asserting that every failed action is appropriate.

22: Text sagt dazu nichts

The article describes video review and an assessment form but identifies no software and gives no information about software used by professional clubs. Neither equivalence nor difference is established.

23: Nein

The initial judgement uses previously unseen clips with unknown outcomes. The continuation is shown only after the judgement is recorded, directly contradicting prior knowledge.

24: Ja

A larger share of unpressured possession can increase completions without improved decisions under comparable conditions. This supports the stated limitation on what the total establishes.

25: Text sagt dazu nichts

The complete article discusses internal assessment and training use. It supplies no spectator information or comparison of attendance before and after adoption.

26: Nein

Groups are based on starting conditions and explicitly include both completed and failed passes. This contradicts grouping only identical outcomes.

27: Ja

Different interpretations of available space motivate a clearer category description. The article also permits other causes of disagreement, consistent with the qualified claim.

28: Text sagt dazu nichts

Players contribute to discussions, but the article states no attendance obligation, consequence of absence or selection condition. Participation alone establishes none of these.

29: Nein

Initial individual entries remain unchanged. Later agreement receives an additional entry, contradicting replacement by a uniform initial assessment.

30: Ja

Recurring difficulties guide specific practice choices, while future opponents, situations and execution prevent a match result prediction from this assessment.
