1: E

E combines prior reporting experience, student eligibility, weekly neighbourhood assignments during term and payment.

2: B

B supplies historical coverage from both newspapers, including the closure, and supports retrieval and comparison.

3: G

G teaches participants to trace proposals through public meeting documents to recorded decisions.

4: I

No available description supplies a complete written German translation of a submitted recording. A is consumed by the example.

5: C

C provides beginner rehearsal with unexpected responses and individual feedback on follow up questions. F concerns leading a group discussion.

6: H

H works with existing interview files and has participants perform both requested editing operations under guidance.

7: I

No available offer sells guaranteed publication of a complete submitted article. Related funding information and reporting employment do not meet that condition.

8: D

D compares both specified income sources for a freely accessible local news service and addresses their consequences for editorial decisions.

9: F

F rehearses the moderator role in editorial audience discussions, including allocating turns and restoring topic focus.

10: I

The bank contains recording and editing activities but no permission to borrow a recorder for an external weekend event.

11: B

The planned purpose is to explain objects through their everyday significance. This key remains provisional until the article is authored.

12: A

The planned method retains themed audio excerpts with their individual origins. Source confirmation is pending.

13: C

The planned role concerns explaining workplace vocabulary. Permission decisions and loan administration remain separate roles.

14: A

The planned juxtaposition concerns different experiences of an agreed change, rather than adjudicating its schedule or chronology.

15: C

The planned explanation limits interpretation to voluntarily contributed accounts and supplies no basis for population frequencies or collective change.

16: B

The planned consequence is a choice of listening depth within the room. The article must establish the relation between the short excerpts and optional longer recordings.

17: A

The planned explanation connects later use with present physical alterations. It is distinct from the general purpose of pairing objects and memories in question 11.

18: C

The planned chronology distinguishes an agreed loan from the unfinished physical preparation required before display.

19: B

The planned causal chain is visitor information, subsequent checking and possible supplementation. It does not imply immediate publication.

20: C

The planned conclusion integrates personal significance, distinct experiences and checked additions across the article. It is not reducible to one logistical detail.

Lesetext 3: Aussagen prüfen · Lesetext 3: Ergebnisse und Vergleichbarkeit

21: Ja

The secondary criterion distinguishes equal win totals according to the results of the opponents actually faced. The source explicitly contrasts two such records.

22: Nein

The initial draw explicitly excludes previous performance and known strength. Later use of opponents' tournament results is a separate ranking operation.

23: Text sagt dazu nichts

The opening identifies students and a university setting. No passage states a participation fee, an exemption or free entry, so neither the claim nor its negation is supported.

24: Nein

Interim positions depend on available information, but the final ranking is explicitly unchanged by a different entry order for the same completed results.

25: Ja

A shared rank means the selected criteria cannot distinguish the records. The source explicitly leaves differences in playing ability unresolved.

26: Text sagt dazu nichts

The article explains why a secondary criterion is used and what it cannot establish. It reports no participant preferences or comparison of participant approval between methods.

27: Nein

The model retains completed encounters in both the record and the calculation after withdrawal. Only future encounters fail to produce results.

28: Ja

Rest intervals are contextual records. The source explicitly excludes them from both ranking criteria and from additional points.

29: Text sagt dazu nichts

The final paragraph compares coverage of direct encounters. Neither that comparison nor any other passage establishes relative organizational effort; fewer direct encounters alone do not establish the stated overall comparison.

30: Ja

The conclusion distinguishes calculable positions from limits arising from unequal opposition, completed encounters and conditions. The conditional claim preserves the separate possibility of shared ranks.
